


Violin Level 4A (Practice)

Identify the key signature of the following piece: _____ Major




Write the major scale that corresponds to the above key. Use accidentals for any sharp and flat notes—do not write a key signature.

The chords in the Violin 2 part below are missing their middle notes. Draw the correct middle note to complete a major triad.




Intervals


