On Festival Day:

1. Before you arrive, please make sure that all measures in the music you will give to the judge have been numbered.
2. Arrive 20 minutes before you are scheduled to perform your solo.
3. Check in at the registration table in the lobby. A helper will direct you to warm-up rooms.
4. Be outside your performance room 5 minutes before your scheduled time. Hand your music to the door monitor. You **MUST** have original music (no photocopies).
5. Once inside, you may test the piano, tune, etc. Wait for the judge to tell you that he or she is ready for you to begin.
6. Stand up and announce your name and the name and composer of your piece before playing.
7. Once you are finished performing, your room monitor will direct you to the theory room. Check in at the teacher's table. A teacher will give you your quiz.
8. Once you've completed your theory quiz, you're done! Please exit the room quietly.
