On Festival Day:

- 1. Before you arrive, please make sure that all measures in the music you will give to the judge have been numbered.
- 2. Arrive 20 minutes before you are scheduled to perform your solo.
- 3. Check in at the registration table in the lobby. A helper will direct you to warm-up rooms.
- 4. Be outside your performance room 5 minutes before your scheduled time. Hand your music to the door monitor. You MUST have original music (no photocopies).
- 5. Once inside, you may test the piano, tune, etc. Wait for the judge to tell you that he or she is ready for you to begin.
- 6. Stand up and announce your name and the name and composer of your piece before playing.
- 7. Once you are finished performing, your room monitor will direct you to the theory room. Check in at the teacher's table. A teacher will give you your guiz.
- 8. Once you've completed your theory quiz, you're done! Please exit the room quietly.
